Healthcare needs are related to chronic illness, particularly diabetes and these tie back to the SDOH needs. There is a shortage of primary care providers in the area. Transportation is limited for Sun River's patients and transportation may be an issue for access to CNYEC. There are bus routes available. Sun River Health does have a site near the new location, but it has not yet opened due to a lack of providers. Gogo Grandparent is recommended as a transportation service relevant to CNYEC. The project is supported. Charity care is important for access affordability and Sun River is interested in agreements for charity care. Also recommended is a lanaguage line and preregistration processes for patients with visual or hearing impairments.

If they need financial aid they fill out an application and may receive financial aid from the foundation. The Foundation averages five to seven patients a month who receive financial aid. Seeta Eye Foundation will provide support for services at any facility. The main challenge from Seeta Eye Foundation's perspective is the long wait times patients experience in scheduling surgery. It is currently three or four months. The project moves CNYEC, which performs cataract and retinal surgeries, next to the Seeta Eye Center. In addition to the expanded space it reduces the travel time for doctors allowing them to do more procedures. The expanded space will reduce wait times. There is better accessibility and parking at the new location. Also, the new location has more services available for family members who are waiting for

The new location is a college area, near Vassar, it is a much more affluent area. There is a significant amount of historical segregation in the city of Poughkeepsie. Transportation is an issue, and transportation is more problematic outside of Poughkeepsie. While Uber and Lyft are available they provide limited coverage. Overall, in terms of impact, the relocation is from the more underserved area in Poughkeepsie to a more well-served area. Transportation is likely more problematic. That is concerning. A important question is whether the added capacity will be supported by staff. A reduction in wait times is good but how certain is that? In terms of support, can't say. For mitigation, the current location is near Mid-Hudson Regional Hospital. Can the Center provide a shuttle? Can they work with Mid-Hudson? Communicate services to the ED and urgent care centers?
